

Blind Carbon Copy (Bcc:) allows email senders to blind copy recipients without visibility to the To: and Cc: recipients.

BCC Issue

We have recently discovered that under certain conditions BCC does not function correctly when a recipient's electronic mail is automatically forwarded from GroupWise to another email system.

This could result in revealing the names of blind copy recipients to all other recipients of an email.

Recommendation

We discourage the use of the BCC function until the entire campus has been migrated to Outlook/Exchange. We suggest simply forwarding a copy of your email to the intended blind copy recipient.

We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause, but there are no technical solutions for this problem and GroupWise does not plan to fix this bug in the near future.
